HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

We set up the altar with a towel, an image of the Virgin Mary, the Bible, a crucifix and a candle beside the image. Next we put two vases with water - one of them with roses to be offered. We have also a basket with the petitions that will be burned at the end. Each mystery we pray, we offer a rose to Our Lady to intercede with God for us.

We start with a song followed by the prayers to the Holy Spirit, Creed, Our Father and 3 Hail Marys. Then we passed the contemplation of the 20 mysteries: Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious. Instead of praying on each mystery 10 Hail Marys, we pray 50 and so we complete a thousand Hail Marys.

We finish by contemplating the 5 wounds of Jesus.

In the Name of the Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit...Amen!

PRAYER TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. MEDITATING THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES

1° - THE ANNUNCIATION (Luke 1, 26-38)

We offer this rose with love to the Father and ask His forgiveness for the times that we didn't hear the proclamation of the Word of God, we didn't pay attention to the good inspirations of our Guardian Angel, and turned away from the Truth.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

2° - MARY VISITS ELIZABETH (Luke 1, 39-56)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times that we weren't willing to assist our neighbor, we did not share either our life or our material possessions. We ask the Lord to strengthen in us faith, hope and charity.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

3° - THE NATIVITY (Luke 2, 1-21)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for our attachment to material things, for abortions, for marital betrayals and for not giving our true value to our families. Through Mary and Joseph we consecrate our families to God with everything we have saying: "Jesus, Mary and Joseph, our family is yours!"

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

4° - THE PRESENTATION IN THE TEMPLE (Luke 2, 22-40)

We offer this rose and we ask forgiveness for our lack of trust and our difficulty in giving God our lives, our concerns, our projects, our victories or failures, our families. We ask the Lord to give us wisdom, purify and sanctify us and to restore our family.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

5° - THE FINDING IN THE TEMPLE (Luke 2, 42-52)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for all those who are away from God, living in serious sins, looking for God in all the wrong places, or walking paths that not lead to the Kingdom of God. We pray to the Lord, through Mary and Joseph, the grace of deliverance, conversion and the eternal salvation for all.

A BIT OF HISTORY

At the beginning of the 13th century, the Church was experiencing violent opposition from the Albigensians, a group who taught that spiritual realities were good and everything material was evil. This was a direct attack against the Incarnation, the Passion, and the Resurrection. They even became violent and murdered a papal legate who had been sent to dialogue with them.

Saint Dominic Guzman was the founder of a religious order called the Order of Preachers. Their mission was to set the world on fire with a love for Jesus through preaching on the sacred mysteries of Christianity. Gifted with great oratorical ability and theological acumen, he hoped to be able to win souls back to Christ rather easily. However, after several years of ardent preaching, he realized that he was not effective and that he needed something more.

In 1208, he begged heaven to come to his aid and give him what he needed to overcome the Albigensians. After three days of solitude in intensive prayer, fasting, and penitential acts, the Queen of Heaven came to his assistance. *"Wonder not that until now you have obtained so little fruit by your labors; you have spent them on a barren soil, not yet watered with the dew of the divine grace. Therefore, preach my Psalter."*

The Marian Psalter existed before Saint Dominic's. He was chosen to be the founder and father of a new way to pray it. The Marian Psalter was prayed as a way of honoring Mary, now it took on apostolic and meditative dimensions as Mary revealed to Dominic mysteries that were to be associated with it. These mysteries directly answered the errors being promoted by the Albigensians by focusing on the Incarnation, Passion, and glorious triumph of Her divine Son.

As the first champion of the Rosary, St Dominic quickly became the most fruitful preacher of his age. The spiritual sword of the rosary had proven itself to be very powerful. (The History and Heroes of a Spiritual Weapon by Fr Donald Calloway, MIC)

Saint Catherine of Bologna is great propagator of the thousand Hail Marys. On Christmas Eve in 1445, the saint spent the night praying and meditating on the Mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God. She was in the midst of reciting the Hail Mary a thousand times in honor of our Virgin Mother when Mary appeared to her and placed the infant Jesus in her arms. In order to mark this event, each year the Sisters of the Poor Clare monastery of Corpus Domini continue the practice of the thousand Hail Marys on Christmas Eve. This devotion quickly spread throughout the Church.

The story of the Rosary had another decisive moment when the Saint John Paul II choose to celebrate his Silver Anniversary with the Rosary mission, adding the five Luminous Mysteries (October 2002). Saint John Paul II confided that "the Rosary is my favorite prayer. Beautiful prayer! Beautiful in its simplicity and depth."

CONTEMPLATION OF THE 5 WOUNDS OF JESUS

MEDITATING THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES

1°- THE BAPTISM OF CHRIST IN THE JORDAN (Matthew 3, 13-17)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for all the people who don't live their Baptism, those who don't believe that Jesus is the son of God and do not accept the existence of the Holy Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We ask God the Father, through Jesus Christ, to shed the Gifts of the Holy Spirit on all mankind, transform hearts and renew the face of the Earth.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

2°- THE WEDDING FEAST AT CANA (John 2, 1-12)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times that we were not attentive to the needs of our brothers, for our failure to pray for them; for not valuing Christian marriage; for the times that we don't trust in the intercession of Mary and in the action of God. We ask the Lord to increase and strengthen in us the spirit of solidarity, friendship and love, saying: "Jesus, I trust in you!"

3°- JESUS' PROCLAMATION OF THE COMING OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD (Mark 1,14-15)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for not accepting the doctrine taught by Jesus; for the times that we embrace false ideologies and philosophies, leaving the Truth to live the lie. We pray the Lord to engrave His Laws in our hearts and give us the grace of a sincere and firm conversion.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

4°- THE TRANSFIGURATION (Mark 9, 2-10)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times we give bad example and do not witness the living Christ with our lives; by scandals caused by famous people and authorities. We pray the Lord to give us the grace of modesty, simplicity and honesty.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

5°- THE INSTITUTION OF THE EUCHARIST (Mark 14, 12-25)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for all who receive Holy Communion without being prepared and by doing so, hurting the Heart of Jesus. We ask the Lord to open our hearts and give us the grace of understanding, so that we can cling more and more to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to offer reparations in order to be one flock with one Shepherd.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

MEDITATING THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES

1°- THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN (Mark 14, 32-52)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times we make bad decisions for lack of prayer and meditation; the times we were unaware and ended up falling into temptation; the times we did not seek peaceful settlement of conflicts; times we did not rely on the love and power of Jesus. We ask the Lord to instill in us the love of prayer, the spirit and the desire for peace.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

2°- THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR (Matthew 27, 26-31)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the sins of the rulers and authorities which, by omission or by abuse of power impose all kind of sufferings, like exaggerated taxes, insufficient wages, unemployment, social injustices, etc. We pray the Lord to soften even the most hardened hearts, bless all the people and all the authorities.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

3°- THE CROWNING WITH THORNS (Mark 15, 15-20)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the sins of blasphemy, challenges and lack of respect for the power and authority of God; the times we accuse, denigrate, calumniate, ridicule, judge and condemn our neighbor, even when we don't have any evidence. We pray the Lord to give us the grace of the Fear of God and love of neighbor.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

4°- THE CARRYING OF THE CROSS (Luke 23, 24-32)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for all those who, feeling the heavy Cross, just abandon it. We ask the Lord to bless and empower all people who bear with dignity and patience their crosses, forgetting themselves for the love of neighbor.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

5°- THE CRUCIFIXION AND DEATH (John 19, 17-37)

We offer this rose and we thank Jesus for his great love for us, which led him to be crucified alive. We ask forgiveness for all the times that we rejected God by not fulfilling His commandments of love; the times that we crucified our neighbor with our selfishness or omission. We ask the Lord to help us to be like Him in our love of our brothers.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

MEDITATING THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES

1°-THE RESURRECTION (Luke 24, 1-12 / I Corinthians 15, 3-5.20-23)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times we took too long to make a Sacramental Confession, keeping our soul from being reborn to God; the times we didn't help our brothers out of a wrong life to live in the light of Christ. We ask the Lord to free us of all the errors and biases that keep us away from the Life of grace and dwell in his Kingdom of Light.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

2°- THE ASCENSION (Acts 1, 1-11)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for all the people who don't believe that Jesus is the Son of God the Father, who was raised, ascended into heaven and is at the right hand of his Father, and who will return to get his followers. We pray to God the Father, through Jesus, we can put in our heart the faith and trust in the Word of Your Son.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

3°- THE DESCENT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (Acts 2, 1-13)

We offer this rose and we thank God for the gifts of the Holy Spirit who is given to us and we ask for forgiveness because they often don't use these gifts to help our brothers. We ask the Lord to make us more receptive to Your Spirit of Love.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

4°- THE ASSUMPTION (Revelation 12, 13-17)

We offer this rose and we thank Mary for all the graces and benefits, that by Her intercession, the Lord gives us. We ask forgiveness for all the blasphemies, injuries and lack of love that reach and hurt the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We pray to God to make us loving children of Mary.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers

5°- THE CORONATION OF MARY (Revelation 12, 1-6)

We offer this rose and ask forgiveness for the times that we do not defend Our Lady when she is attacked by enemies. We want to devote our lives, our family and our nation in the hands of Mary Most Holy, reaffirming our love and our trust in our Mother and Queen.

- Our Father, 50 Hail Marys, Glory Be, Invocation prayers
