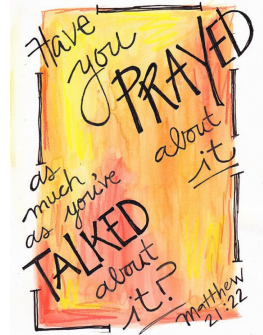

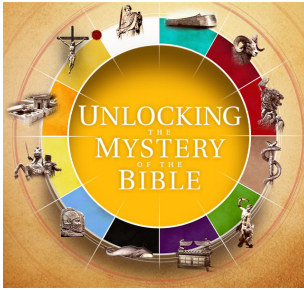

UNLOCKING THE MYSTERY OF THE BIBLE

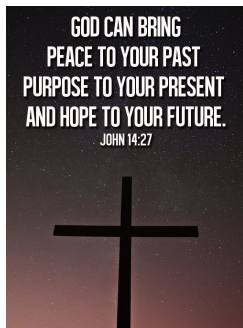

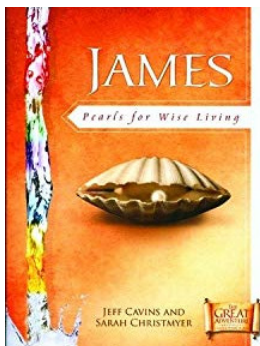


MEN'S EVENING BIBLE STUDY

WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY - JAMES: PEARLS FOR WISE LIVING

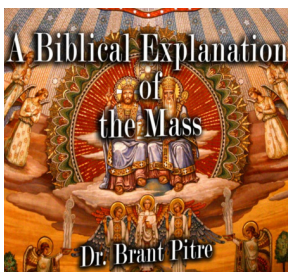

KINGDOM OF HAPPINESS: LIVING THE BEATITUDES IN EVERYDAY LIFE

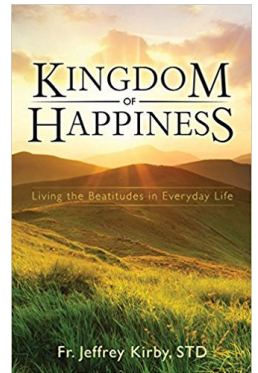

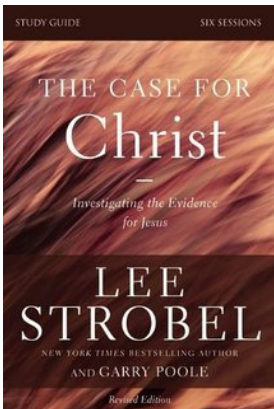


BAPTISM PREPARATION FOR PARENTS AND GODPARENTS

JESUS THE BRIDEGROOM

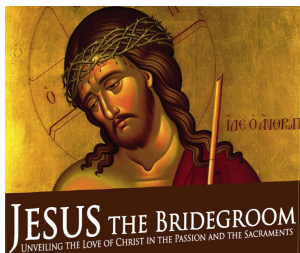

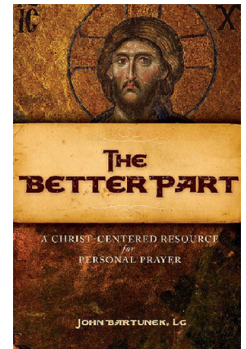


MEN'S WEEKLY GOSPEL REFLECTION

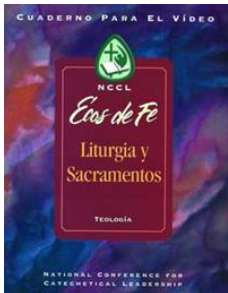

SISTEMA INTEGRAL DE NUEVA EVANGELIZACION

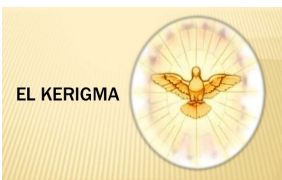

Lembra Abraão que aceitou a chamada de Deus para partir rumo à outra terra; Moisés a quem Deus ordenou “Vai, Eu te envio”; Jeremias a quem disse “Irás aonde Eu te ordenar”; Jesus com o seu “Ide e fazei discípulos de todos os povos” e “evangelizai toda criatura”. Por conseguinte, o Papa afirma, incluindo-se, que “hoje todos somos chamados a esta nova “saída” missionária: sair da própria comodidade e ter a coragem de alcançar todas as periferias que precisam da luz do Evangelho”
