THE TURNING POINT: ENCOUNTERS WITH JESUS IN THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

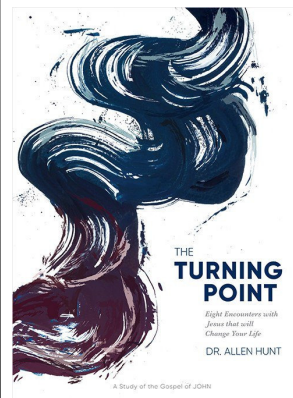

CASE FOR CHRIST: A JOURNALIST'S PERSONAL INVESTIGATION

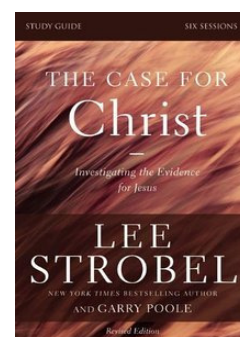

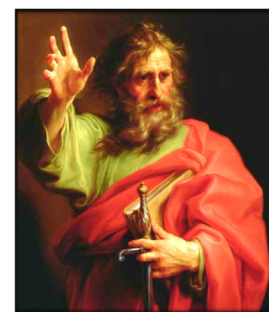
DISCUSSION WITH DAVID: PAUL, THE MAN AND HIS AUTHENTIC 7 LETTERS

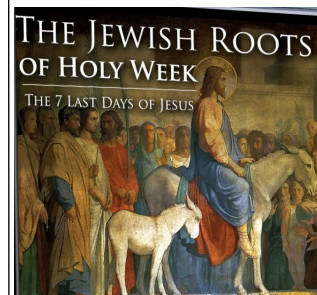
THE JEWISH ROOTS OF HOLY WEEK

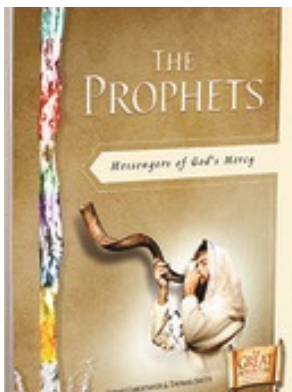

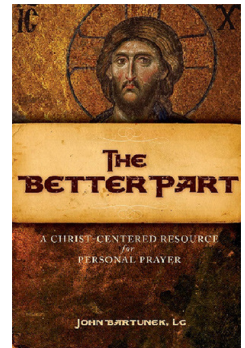


MEN'S WEEKLY GOSPEL REFLECTION

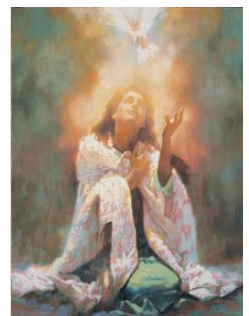


WOMEN'S GOSPEL REFLECTION

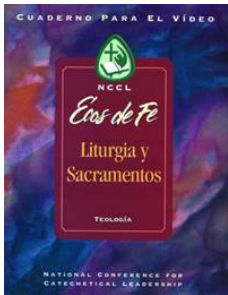




RICA – RITO DE INICIACION CRISTIANA PARA ADULTOS

SISTEMA INTEGRAL DE NUEVA EVANGELIZACION

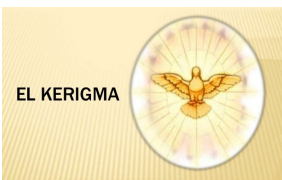

EVANGELII GAUDIUM: "A ALEGRIA DO EVANGELHO"

Exortação Apostólica do Papa Francisco sobre o anúncio do Evangelho no mundo atual. Lembra Abraão que aceitou a chamada de Deus para partir rumo à outra terra; Moisés a quem Deus ordenou “Vai, Eu te envio”; Jeremias a quem disse “Irás aonde Eu te ordenar”; Jesus com o seu “Ide e fazei discípulos de todos os povos” e “evangelizai toda criatura”. Por conseguinte, o Papa afirma, incluindo-se, que “hoje todos somos chamados a esta nova “saída” missionária: sair da própria comodidade e ter a coragem de alcançar todas as periferias que precisam da luz do Evangelho.”
