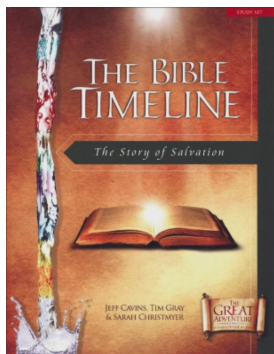

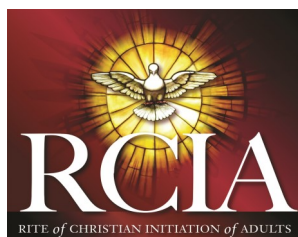

OREMUS: LET US PRAY

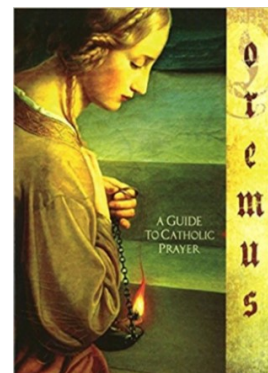

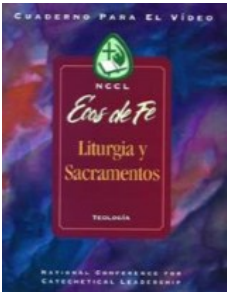




RICA – RITO DE INICIACION CRISTIANA PARA ADULTOS
