



Service Requirements for Confirmation 10th Grade

Service Hours for Confirmation

Service to others should be a response to a call. What does this mean? When we read the words of the scripture below, what are the actions that He is “calling” us to do?

Luke 10:27 “He answered, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself.’”

Upon reflection on this scripture, what will be your action to this call of service?

We will reflect on this question with the confirmation candidates and their sponsors during our Candidate/Sponsor Workshop (*Sat, Oct. 26 1:00-5:00 pm*). They will then develop a service project that will reflect their individual call. This is a way for the candidate and sponsor to build their relationship in their faith together. After they decide on their call to service, they will decide when and where to carry out their service. After the service is complete, the candidate will report on their call by filling out the *Service Reflection* online form via our website.

The candidate should discuss the questions found on the online form with their sponsor prior to filling out the form. They will be asked to write 1 to 2 paragraphs for each of these questions:

How did your service project make a difference and for whom?

How did your service project reflect Catholic Social Teaching?

Why did you choose this project?

What did you discover about yourself by participating in this project?

The online Service Reflection Form must be submitted by February 1, 2020.
