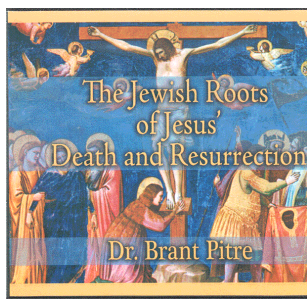


## WALKING WITH PURPOSE - BIBLE STUDY FOR WOMEN

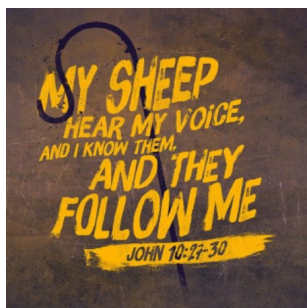


## THE JEWISH ROOTS OF JESUS' DEATH AND RESURRECTION
