I am very pleased to present our Annual Stewardship Report for the fiscal year that spans July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

More than 60 years ago, a small group of dedicated Catholics worked very hard to establish what is now your spiritual home! Think about that – a small group who heard and heeded the call to build a place where tens of thousands would eventually worship, learn, and grow in faith.



The growth of our parish over these 60-plus years has been due to the dedication and determination of so many faithful servants. And the good news is that this continues even today. Our parish is filled with dedicated stewards who continue to grow in faith, teach our youth, help those in need, serve in one of our liturgical ministries so we can celebrate 20 Masses each week, sit with Jesus in Adoration 121 hours each week, and lend their talents serving in one of our more than 80 ministries.

And when this happens, when our congregation is engaged in the life of our parish, the financial part always falls into place. Our parish's financial standing was strong again this past fiscal year. Thanks to your support and tithing, our parish's financial strength gives us the confidence to move forward with plans to greatly improve our campus facilities.

Because our parish continues to grow in the number of households, we naturally will need to continue to grow to meet the needs of our faithful. This is a wonderful opportunity! Our Catholic faith, here at Saint Jude, is thriving. Let's now band together, as our founders did all those years ago, to renew our campus and set the stage for the next 60 years.

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

As the members of our Finance Council, we are pleased to share with you the Annual Stewardship Report for Saint Jude the Apostle Parish for the Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2025. Under the pastoral leadership of Monsignor Joe Corbett and the parish staff members, our parish continues to enjoy sound financial results reflective of our growing and engaged community. The responsible management of our financial resources and the consistent monetary support from each of you, our fellow parishioners, continues to position our parish to pursue our spiritual goals.

In the 2025 fiscal year, our parish's offertory grew once again, as a result of your kind and generous stewardship. In addition to completing the paydown of all parish outstanding debt last year and continuing to fund a diverse and growing list of ministries and activities in 2025, we have commenced construction on our new parish rectory.

Our parish's offertory comprises our primary source of revenue. For this fiscal year, our offertory was \$4.2 million, up 5.3% over the prior fiscal year. All other revenues, including donations, fees, bequests, the Archbishop's Annual Appeal refund, the Men's Club donations, and our preschool, amounted to \$1.0 million for total fiscal year revenue of \$5.3 million, which represents a healthy increase of 9.7% over the prior fiscal year.

Once again, despite the many inflationary pressures on the costs of services and supplies, total parish expenses in fiscal 2025 were \$4.2 million, an increase of 6.6% and, importantly, a slower rate of increase than our revenues.

Overall, our parish operations generated revenue in excess of expenses of \$1.1 million, an increase of approximately 24% which allowed us to maintain our parish facilities, support all our parish operational needs, and increase our total parish cash balance.

With a continued healthy financial position, our growing parish is blessed with the ability to plan for the future and begin work on the significant additional facility improvements needed to ensure we can thrive for generations to come.
